As we conclude 2025, Techo Startup Center reflects on a year marked by focused execution, integration, and steady progress. Building on foundations established in previous years, 2025 represented an important step toward strengthening programs, systems, and partnerships that support Cambodia's startup and digital business ecosystem.

Throughout the year, our efforts concentrated on improving market readiness and program effectiveness. Flagship initiatives such as the Digital Platform Accelerator and Reverse Innovation supported startups in commercialization, early market expansion, and partnership development. These efforts were complemented by ecosystem initiatives including SparkMeet and the Turing Hackathon, which nurtured emerging talent, encouraged collaboration, and helped more startups advance toward sustainable operations and job creation.

In parallel, 2025 saw continued progress in the integration of national digital platforms. CamDX, CamDigiKey, CamDL, and TSC AI were further developed to support trusted data exchange, digital identity verification, and AI-enabled insights across the public and private sectors. Key initiatives such as Online Business Registration Phase III, the E-Service for Business (ESB) Generic Template, business.gov.kh, and the Secure Transactions Filing Office (SETFO) also contributed to simplifying business registration and licensing processes.

Digital adoption efforts continued to expand through the Enterprises Go Digital program, supporting MSMEs across sectors and regions to strengthen digital capabilities, formalize operations, and improve competitiveness.

These achievements were made possible through the dedication of our team and the close collaboration among government institutions, development partners, the private sector, and the startup community. As we move forward, the foundations strengthened in 2025 provide a solid base for continued learning, refinement, and progress in the years ahead.

## SPARKMEET SEASON 4

GROWING TOGETHER: DIVERSITY, INCLUSION, AND SUSTAINABLE INNOVATION

SparkMeet is a community-driven program that connects students, tech enthusiasts, aspiring entrepreneurs, and ecosystem stakeholders to share practical insights and real-world startup experiences.

In 2025, SparkMeet Season 4 focused on two sub programs, reflecting Techo Startup Center’s commitment to diversity and sustainable growth within Cambodia’s startup ecosystem. The program engaged a total of **378 participants**, achieved **50% female participation**, and recorded a **90%** overall satisfaction rate.

### INCLUSIVE PROGRAM: “WOMEN INNOVATORS BOOTCAMP”

Focuses on empowering women with digital, entrepreneurial, and leadership skills through a 6-week expert-led training. It targets students, early-career professionals, aspiring entrepreneurs, and women looking to grow their network in the startup ecosystem.

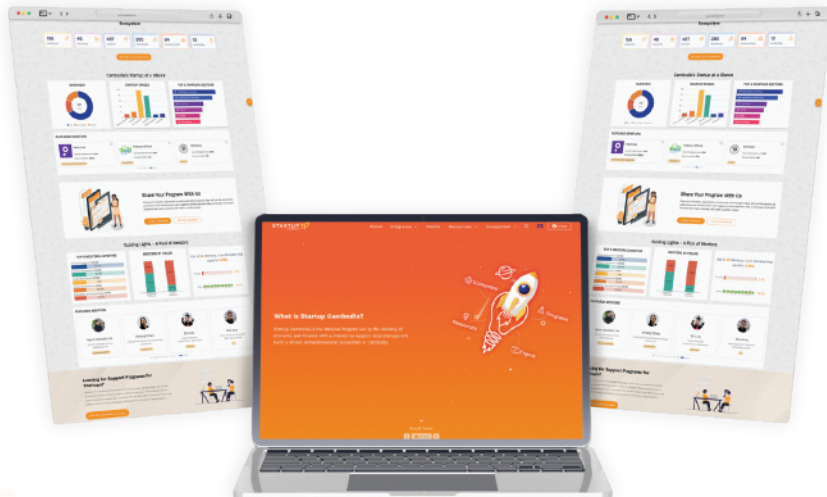

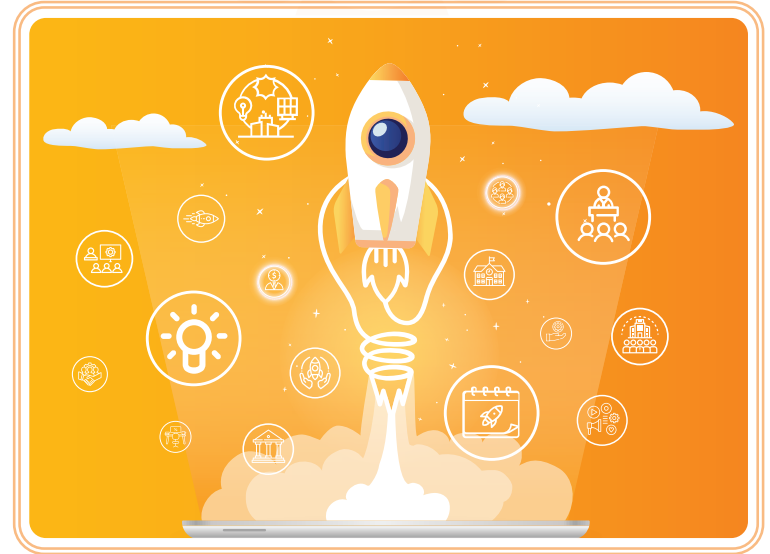

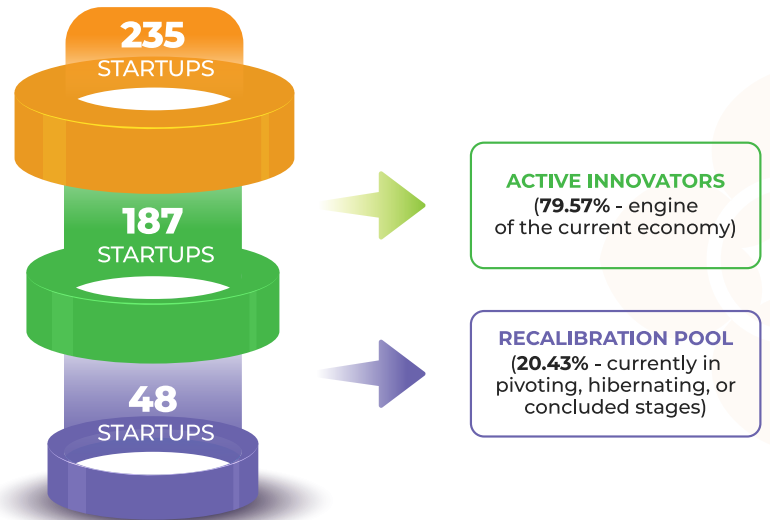
## A GATEWAY TO CAMBODIA'S STARTUP ECOSYSTEM

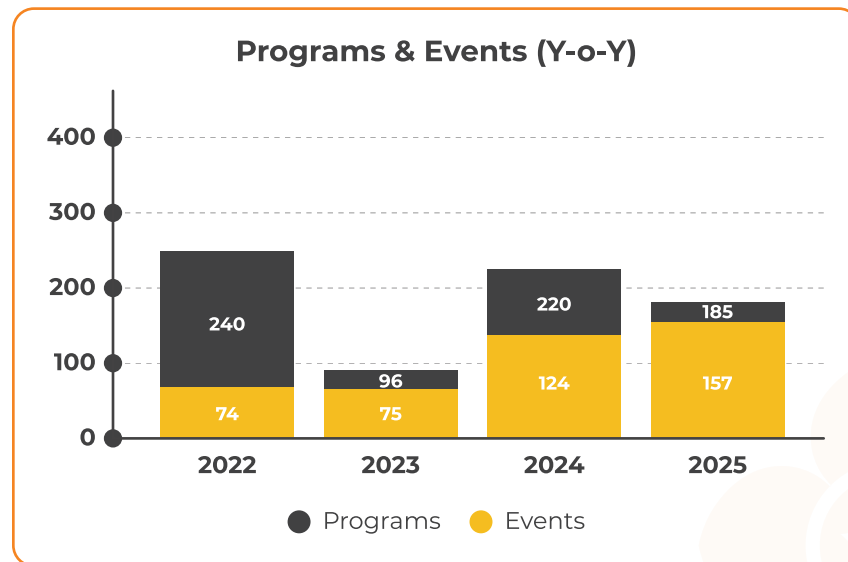

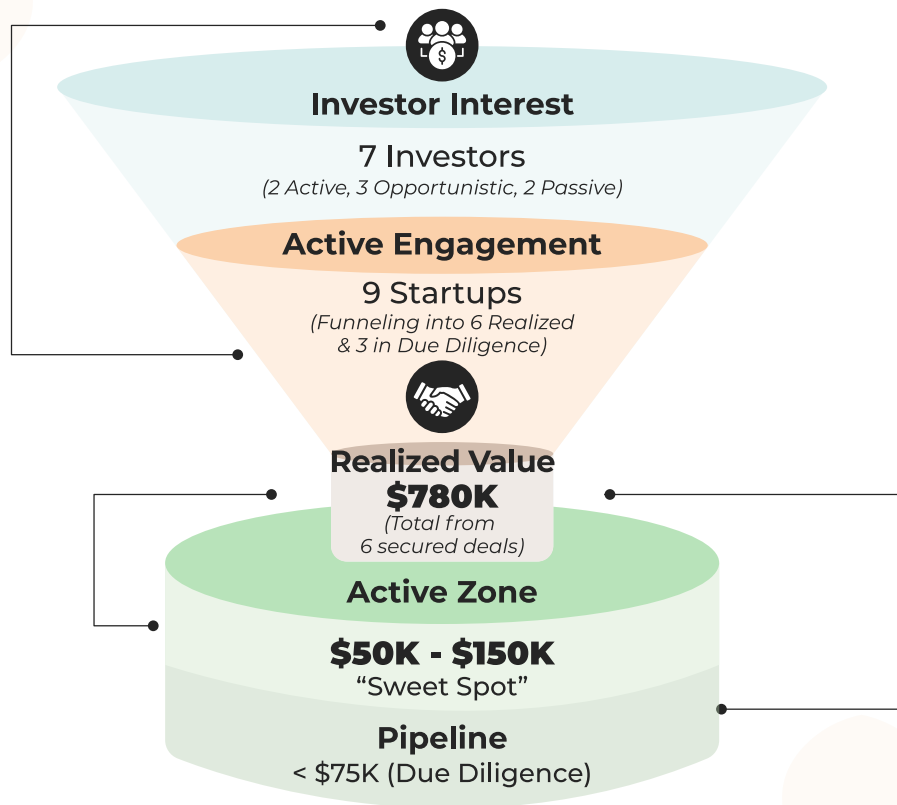

## KEY HIGHLIGHT ON FUNDING & GRANTS 2025: INNOVATION THROUGH DIVERSIFIED CAPITAL

Based on 2025 survey of seven active institutional and private investors, the Cambodian ecosystem is experiencing a shift toward more disciplined vetting as capital remains selective. While investor interest exists, the primary challenge remains a limited pipeline of investable, high-growth startups. Six of nine identified startups secured est. \$780K, while three remain in due diligence, the current landscape reveals an "**investment readiness gap**" highlights a need to bridge the divide between investor interest and realized deals.

In 2025, Cambodia's startup ecosystem saw 45 startup programs and award recognitions offering equity-free cash grants (pre-seed, seed and cash prizes), collectively organized by 19 ESOs. These programs distributed a total of 2.1 billion riels across 191 winning startups/innovators/teams, providing critical funding for early-stage and potential startups across key sectors.



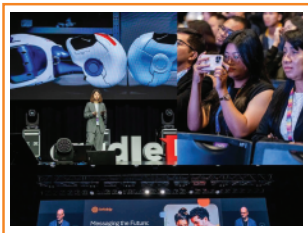

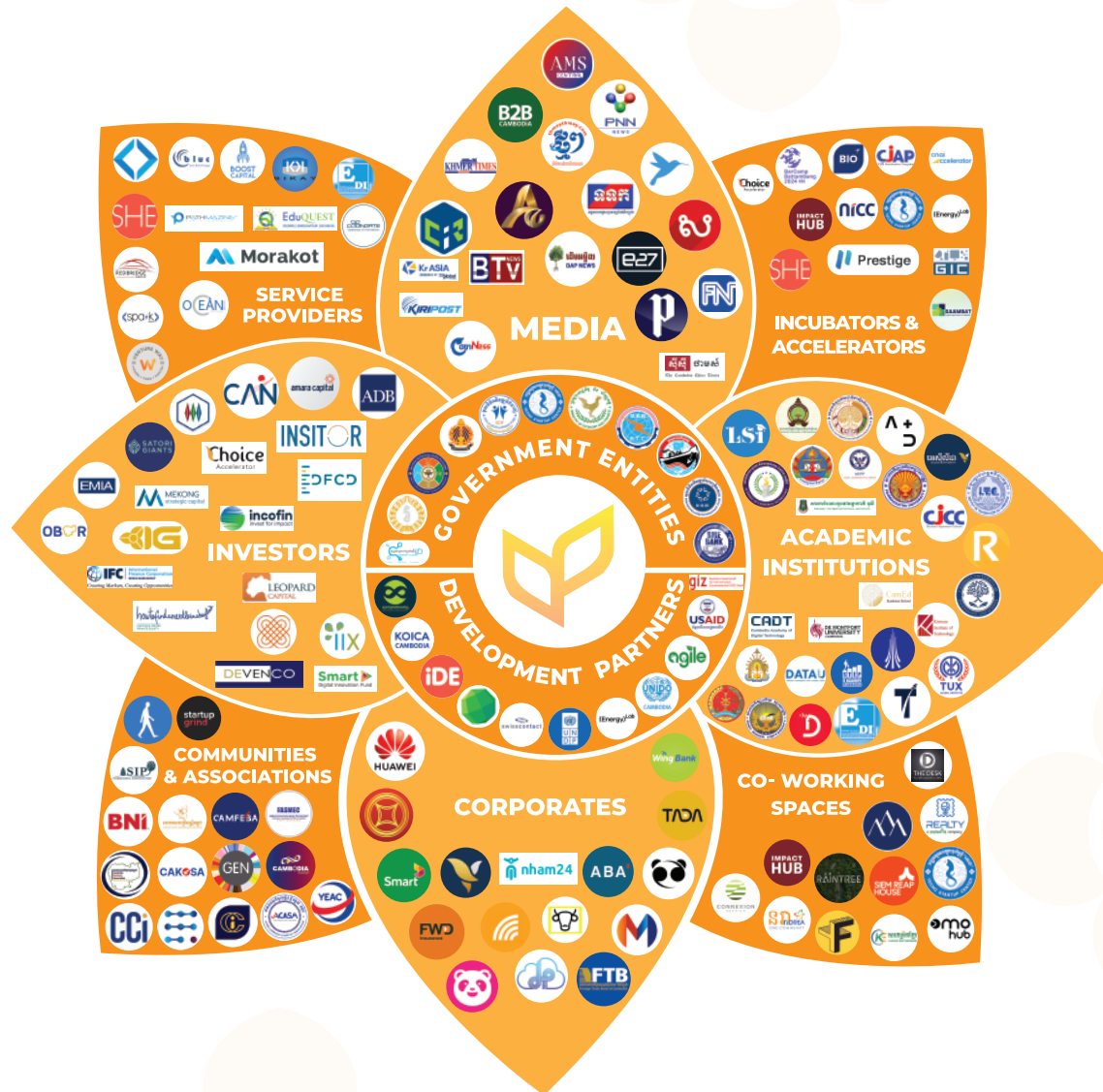

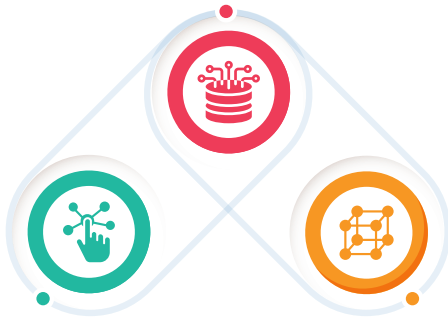


CamDX stands for **Cambodia Data eXchange**, which adopts the model of X-Road of Estonia. CamDX is a unified yet decentralized data exchange layer between information systems that offers a standardized and secure way to provide and consume services. CamDX ensures confidentiality, integrity, and interoperability between a multitude of different data exchange parties.

## THREE COMPONENTS OF DATA EXCHANGE

### INFRASTRUCTURE

Secure data sharing and exchange with real-time integration



### TECHNOLOGY

Modern API gateway; scalable; enable service interoperability; empower multilateral communication; secure by design

### LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Backed by the Royal Government of Cambodia, compliant of data sharing and security in form of CamDX sub-decree

## DESIGN PRINCIPLES

1

### DISTRIBUTED

CamDX is a distributed system with no central database performing only data exchange.

2

### DO NOT OWN DATA

CamDX neither stores nor sees the exchanged data. CamDX only captures metadata for monitoring and reporting purposes.

3

### RELIABLE

No single point of failure. Failure could be partial. Each registry owner can employ proactive measures against any kinds of attack.

4

### HETEROGENEOUS

CamDX connects systems built on any platforms and technologies of choice.

5

### EASE OF USE

All communications in CamDX are based on web services, preferably REST API, and therefore can be used by all developers.

6

### SECURE

CamDX provides enterprise-class security at the application level by ensuring the authenticity, integrity, and non-repudiation of the exchanged data.
